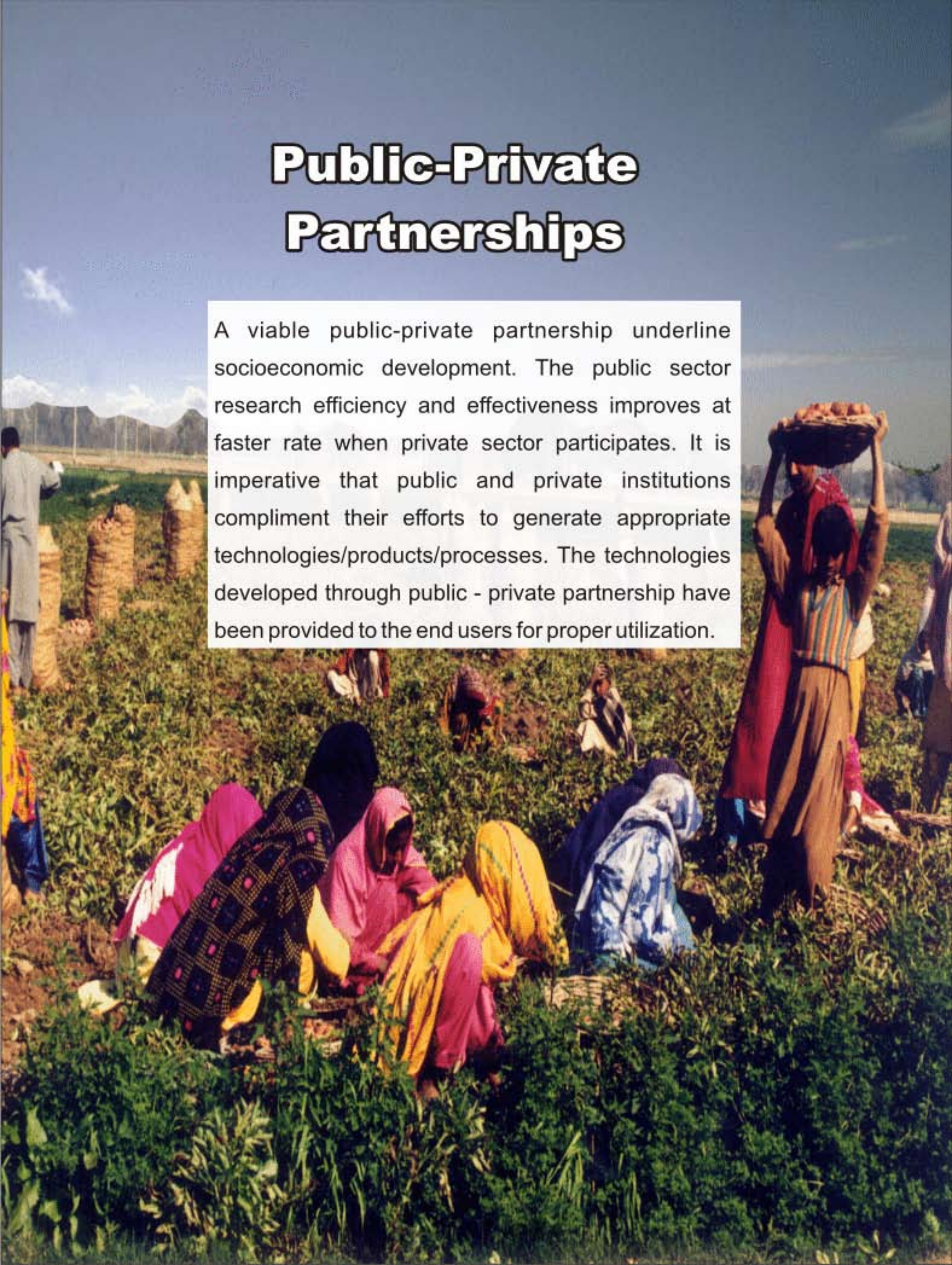


Public-Private Partnerships

A viable public-private partnership underline socioeconomic development. The public sector research efficiency and effectiveness improves at faster rate when private sector participates. It is imperative that public and private institutions compliment their efforts to generate appropriate technologies/products/processes. The technologies developed through public - private partnership have been provided to the end users for proper utilization.



PARC has attempted to commercialize the PARC-generated technologies through public-private partnership by signing Memorandum of Understanding (MoUs) and agreements.

- Efforts were made to commercialize Mobile Seed Processing Unit developed by FMI, NARC Engineers. A formal MoU with private manufacturer is of its completed;
- PARC signed an MoU with Competitiveness Support Fund (CSF), established under section 42 of the companies ordinance, 1984 as a joint initiative of Ministry of Finance (MoF), Government of Pakistan (GOP) and United States Agency for International Development (USAID), for mutual cooperation in development of Pakistan's agriculture; and
- PARC private agribusiness company for commercializing and marketing of PARC generated agricultural technologies is registered from Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan (SECP).
